

How to set up the BNZ Business app on your iPhone

This guide will help you install and set up the BNZ Business app on your iPhone.

To get started, your business or organisation needs to be registered for Internet Banking for Business and you as a user on the site.

You can register at <u>bnz.co.nz/registerforib4b</u> or ask your Internet Banking for Business administrator to set you up as a user on an existing site.

To set up the BNZ Business app, you'll need:

- Your Internet Banking for Business nine-digit access number, User ID, and password
- Your smartphone with a compatible Apple iOS
- An internet connection or data. Once you've downloaded the app, mobile banking is free for all customers on 2degrees, Spark, Skinny, and One NZ network when in New Zealand.



Step 1.

Open the App Store on your iPhone and type '**BNZ Banking'** in the search bar at the top of the screen.



Step 2.

Tap **Get** or the **download icon** to start installing the app. Depending on your settings, you may be asked to enter your Apple password.



Step 3.

Tap **Open.**



Step 4.

Tap **Login** when Welcome is displayed.



Step 5.

Enter your nine-digit access number, User ID, Internet Banking for Business password, and tap **Login.**

Tip: The access number is the nine-digit number sent to you via email at time of registration. It can also be obtained by contacting your Internet Banking for Business Site Administrator.

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Step 6

If we have your details, you'll complete your setup using your email address and mobile phone number.

Check the details are correct and tap **Continue**.

Tip: If the information is incorrect or requires updating, contact your Internet Banking for Business Site Administrator to update your details before continuing to the next step.

Step 7.

An SMS verification code will be sent to your mobile phone. Enter the 6-digit number in the 'SMS Code' field.

Once you've entered the code 'Confirming your code' will appear on your screen.



Step 8.

You'll also be emailed a verification code (this may take a few minutes to show up).

Type the four-digit code in 'Enter code'.



Step 9.

Turn on to enable biometric login on compatible devices using your fingerprint or facial recognition.

You can tap **Not now** if you'd prefer to set it up later.

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Nice work.

You now have access to your banking anytime and anywhere.

Tip: If you already have BNZ Business app on your smartphone to access another Internet Banking for Business site you'll need to complete a <u>NetGuard</u> token consolidation form.

Security tip

It's important to sign out of Internet Banking for Business once you're done and use a secure internet connection.

Make sure that you always type <u>bnz.co.nz</u> when you visit our website or do your online banking. We'll never email you links to the BNZ Internet Banking for Business login page or ask you to tell us your password.

A Business Banking Administrator can also disable the app in their administration settings.
